(4) U10 AND UNDER: When a player <u>deliberately</u> heads the ball in a game, an indirect free kick (IFK) should be awarded to the opposing team from the spot of the offense. If the deliberate header occurs within the goal area, the IFK should be taken on the goal area line parallel to the goal line at the point nearest to where the infringement occurred. If a player does not deliberately head the ball, then play should continue.

* Any violation of these rules by a coach may result in sanctioning, up to and including that coach's dismissal. For U9 and above age groups, violations may also result in forfeiture of the game.
